GEOGRAPHY DRILL

1. Give each student a blank map, key, and marker.
2. Student adds any features to the map that they can from memory.
3. Using the key they then complete the features chosen so far.
4. Once the map can be labeled confidently, then the student adds three new features to the map to practice. Erase.
5. Repeat often until entire map key is learned.

Extend the lesson:

If you want to extend the lesson you can use your geography terms as copy work for handwriting practice for little ones who can't fit the terms on the map. They also make great spelling words for older kids.

Share books and videos in your Morning Time about the continents you are learning to make the locations come to life for your kids.
